

BAD WEATHER

In case of bad weather forecast (snow storm, freezing rain) the Lycée Français de Toronto follows **TDSB's instructions** (Toronto District School Board, <http://www.tdsb.on.ca/>).

1. Bad weather starts BEFORE the beginning of the school day :

If School buses are canceled, an email will be sent out to all LFT families before 7am. School will remain open and class will continue as far as possible.

If a decision to close the school is taken, a message will be posted on our website and an email will be sent out to all LFT families before 7am. Please take this into account as there will be no class or daycare. **This situation is rare.**

2. Bad weather occurs during school day :

School will remain open and we will ensure children supervision until parents arrive (even after regular hours).

If possible, classes will take place as usually scheduled.

However, if for any reasons, Parents wish to pick up their children **during the day :**

Elementary / Primary School : Parents must **send an email to the Class Teacher** and the **Administration of Primary School.**

Secondary School (Grade 6 to 12) : Parents must **send an email or call Vie Scolaire** (416-924-1789 ext 233). Please note that students will not be permitted to leave LFT if we do not receive the parental consent.

- *When temperature and/or windchill factor indicates -28°C or lower children will remain indoor.*
- *When temperature and/or windchill factor indicates -20°C to -28°C, recesses may be shortened depending on local conditions.*
